Dear Justice Kapnick:


This letter is written on behalf of the members of the Steering Committee to respectfully request that the Court grant the Steering Committee permission to file its Supplemental Memorandum of Law in Support of the Motion to Compel the Inside Institutional Investors' Settlement Communications, including the attached Exhibit A ("Settlement Communications Brief") under seal.

The Settlement Communications Brief contains references to multiple documents which the Trustee and the Inside Institutional Investors have designated as "Confidential" under the Protective Order governing this case. (Doc. No. 333.) Paragraph 8 of the Protective Order provides that, "[a]ny party seeking to file . . . briefs constituting, referring to, containing, appending, summarizing, or excerpting information or materials designated "Confidential" . . . must obtain leave of Court." Accordingly, the Steering Committee respectfully requests that the Court enter a sealing order which allows the Steering Committee to file its unredacted Settlement Communications Brief under seal.

The governing Protective Order further states that "[a]ny sealing request shall include a party's proposed redactions." (P.O. ¶ 8.) Thus, the Steering Committee is also submitting to chambers a courtesy copy of the *redacted* Settlement Communications Brief, as well as a courtesy copy of the *unredacted* Settlement Communications Brief for Your Honor's review.²

¹ Although the Steering Committee does not concede that the documents referenced in the brief are "Confidential," the designation of such materials as "Confidential" is sufficient to trigger the Steering Committee's obligation to request permission to file the materials under seal. The Steering Committee expressly reserves the right to challenge the designation of any materials marked "Confidential" and/or "Attorney's Eyes Only."

² The Steering Committee will also submit a courtesy copy of the Affirmation of Michael A. Rollin, attached to which are exhibits cited in the Settlement Communications Brief and which will be electronically filed with the brief at the appropriate time.



Neither the redacted nor the unredacted version of the Settlement Communications Brief will be filed with the Court via NYSCEF at this time, as the Protective Order contemplates that such filing occur only after the Court issues a sealing order.³ The Steering Committee may, however, file the redacted version of the brief as a "secure" document while this sealing request is pending. (See P.O. ¶ 8.)

For Your Honor's convenience, enclosed is a proposed Sealing Order.

We look forward to appearing before Your Honor at the upcoming conference.
